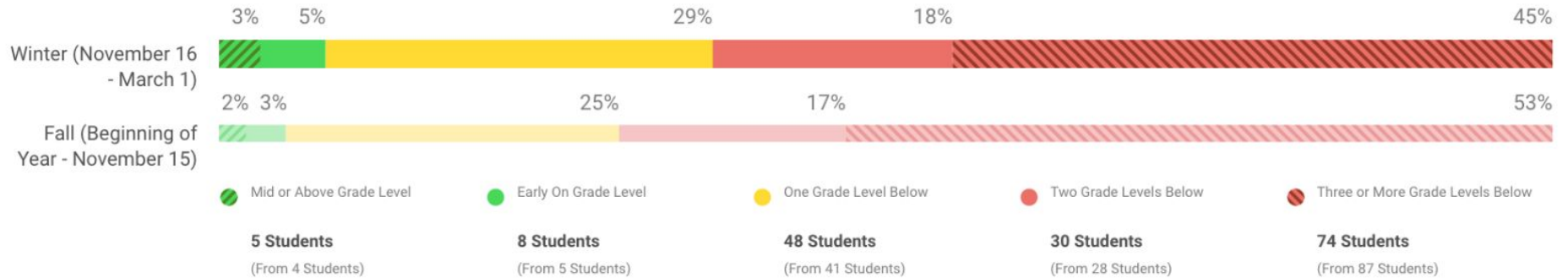

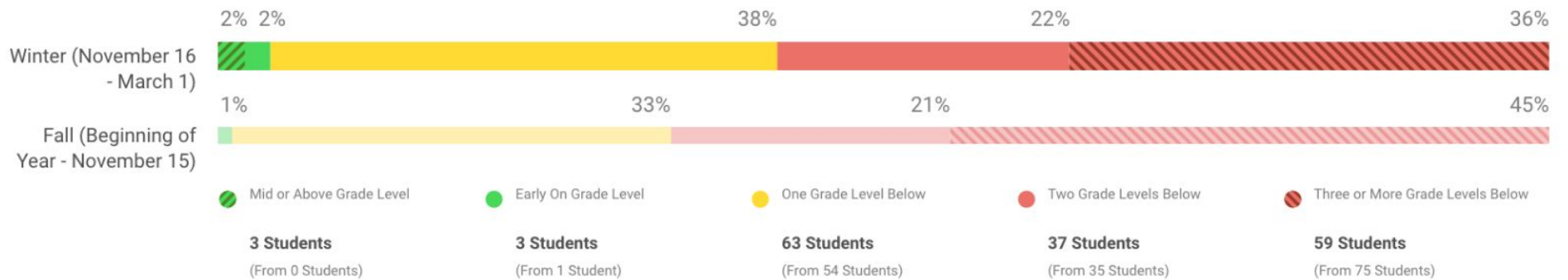
Placement by Domain



HGCS Current Levels - Math

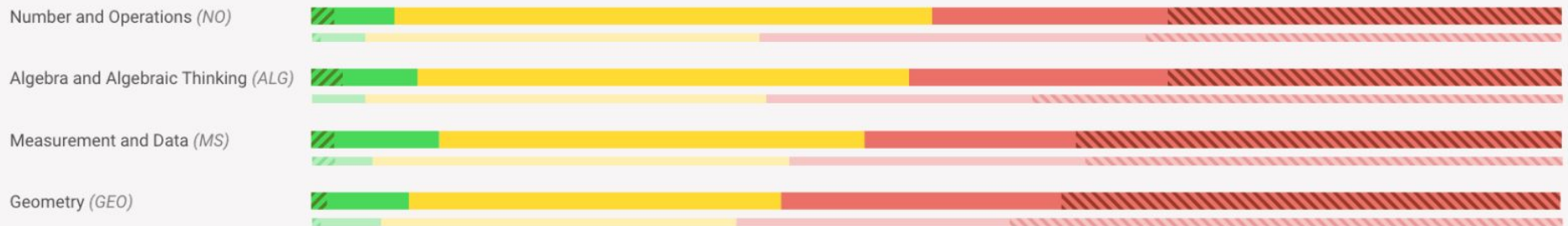
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Placement by Domain



Big Takeaways

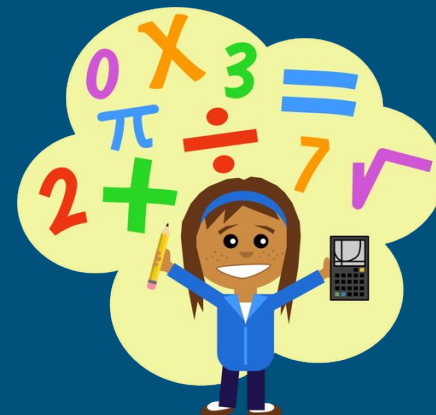
Reading

- Students are most successful in areas that are memorizable
 - Phonics & High Frequency Words
- We need more support in areas that require understanding and making connections with reading
 - Reading comprehension
- Student vocabulary level is reduced compared to other years



Math

- Math is an overall area of weakness
- Students are most successful in the hands on areas of math
 - Measurement and data
- Students need more support in basic fluency
 - Adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing
- Students need more practice in using math problem solving skills



What is HGCS plan to help students

- Students will be receiving interventions daily from their teachers
 - In- class support small group support
- Students who are scoring 2 grade levels below will also receive additional interventions from outside the classroom sources
 - Small group pull outs 1-3 times per week



What can you do to support your students?

- Overall School Engagement
 - Ask about what your student is learning
 - Make an effort for students to attend school every day
 - Reach out to teachers to see what support your student needs
 - Schedule a conference with your student's teacher (whenever you have questions!)
- Reading
 - Read with your students or go with them to select books at their reading level
 - Make an effort to encourage your to read before technology
 - Ask your students questions about their reading
- Math
 - Practice basic math skills (counting, adding, multiplying) at home with your student
 - Consider using flashcards to support fluency
 - Ask them to help with Math in daily life (adding grocery items together, measuring a picture, weighing fruit)
